The Worcester Township Board of Supervisors, during its scheduled meeting on May 16, 2018, will conduct Public Hearings commencing after 7:30PM at Community Hall, 1031 Valley Forge Rd, Fairview Village, to consider enactment of the following Ordinances:

Ordinance 2018-276. An Ordinance to establish and amend various sections of the Township Code regarding: temporary signage, including signage definition and permitted posting duration, number, area, height, installation, maintenance, removal, and illumination; signage area requirements for uses in residential and agricultural areas and Village overlay areas; number, area, height, installation, maintenance, removal, and illumination requirements for neighborhood identification signs; and, permitted private car sale signage.

Ordinance 2018-277. An Ordinance to establish and amend various sections of the Township Code regarding: solicitation permit requirements; Residential Life-Care Facility use definition and minimum lot size; accessory structure setback requirements; permit requirements to repair existing structures in a floodplain; driveway pillar requirements; deck encroachments into a setback; impervious coverage in a R-150 Zoning District; and, a spelling correction.
