Below please find a brief update on the Army Reserve Base:

- The Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has asked the US Army to conduct additional tests, and to submit a plan of action to DEP, by October 7. DEP's letter to the US Army is posted to the Township website, worcestertwp.com. The Township will post additional information to the website as information becomes available.
- The Township's environmental consultant for the Army Reserve Base project will attend this month's Board of Supervisors Work Session Meeting, to be held on Wednesday, September 21, at Community Hall, 1031 Valley Forge Road, in Fairview Village. The consultant will be available beginning at 6:30pm to discuss PFOA and PFOS, additional tests to be conducted by the US Army, and possible next steps to be taken by the US Army.
