Making a Difference

Formed in 1959, the Worcester Volunteer Fire Department has been serving Worcester residents and surrounding communities with entirely volunteers. Day or night, rain or shine, our volunteers are there when our community needs them most. However, without a continued stream of new volunteers, our ability to provide volunteer emergency services in the future could be impacted.

How Can I Help?

The Worcester Volunteer Fire Department is comprised of many different types of members. We have firefighters, junior firefighters (ages 14-18), apparatus drivers, fire police, and administrative members. We have needs at all levels. All training is provided by the department and no prior experience is required, just the desire to help others in your community.

Different Roles

Firefighter (ages 18+)

- Main function of the fire department

Apparatus Driver (ages 21+)

- Apparatus drivers DO NOT need a CDL License, will undergo driver training with the departments engineering staff to become certified to operate the apparatus

Junior Firefighter (ages 16-18)

- Jr. Firefighters are allowed to respond to calls on the apparatus but are not allowed inside structures or in dangerous scenarios

Cadet Firefighters (ages 14-16)

- Will not respond to emergencies but will train with the department and take part in department events

Fire Police (ages 18+)

- Traffic and Crowd Control at emergency scenes

When Will I Have Time For This ?

As a department, we understand that it is hard to ask people to give their time in their already busy lives. All we ask of our members is to give what they can. Our membership varies from students, to people with families, to people who are retired. Being a volunteer first responder can fit into ALL schedules.
