I attended the Worcester Planning Commission Meeting last night. The agenda and handout packet did not include any correspondence from the Montgomery County Planning Commission and/or Mat Shelley concerning the Methacton Conditional use application and/or project. Chairman Todd informed the public that he was in possession of a letter from the MONTCO Planning Commission regarding the Methacton conditional use application/project dated about 9/12/13. Mr. Todd when asked, did not make copies for members of the public and refused to provide copies to members of the public during the meeting. He stated that he would attach copies to the minutes not realizing that the conditional use hearing was in approx. 2 weeks. Approval and posting of the minutes will not occur until next month. That being said, no adequate resolution to providing the letter was obtained at the meeting.

I would like a copy of the letter sent by the Montgomery County Planning Commission and/or Mat Shelley to the Worcester Planning Commission on or about 9/12/13, referred to by Gordon Todd at the Worcester Planning Commission Meeting on 9/12/13 regarding the Methacton conditional use application and/or project.
