The Planning Commission deliberated the LI ordinance at its most recent meeting. Mr. Todd ruled that I wasn't entitled to make inquiries about the ordinance and went on to note, **"I'm telling you, that's the way it's going to be"**. **Fellow Board member Mr. Rotondo added**, "This has got to keep going because **I'm not staying here until God knows when**". I made the statement that "This was a public meeting, I am allowed to ask questions", a unelected, unappointed individual representing an applicant for a "zoning change" stated, "You're coming in a little late to the party", "I don't think at this stage, we're working on this." Supervisor Caughlan was permitted to converse freely with the Board and the applicant without any restriction by Mr. Todd. A few simple answers would have helped avoid this RTK request.
