I would like any and or all communications (letters, memo's faxes and/or emails; regardless as to whether they are on the personal computers and personal email accounts of Township staff and of the Supervisors) between the Manko Firm sp? including its attorneys collectively and/ individually and Worcester Township including but not limited to the Board of Supervisors collectively and individually as well as the Township Solicitor having anything to do with;

1. Any and/or all environmental/hazardous material testing at the North Penn Army Reserve Base site including but not limited to toxins, chemicals and/or hazardous materials.
2. DEP and their testing procedures.
3. DEP and whether their testing procedures were deficient in any way.
4. DEP and whether any additional testing at the site was recommended by anyone.
5. Department of Defense recommendations and documentation that support that they are liable and responsible for a "clean up" in the event that the Township acquires the property and discovers toxic materials that require removal and clean-up.
6. Any recommendations as to whether the Township would be exposed to liability if no further testing is done at the Nike site and the Township acquires the site.
7. The total amount of money expended to date to the Manko law firm for work performed relative to the Nike (North Penn Army Reserve Base). If under RTK you cannot do that then the AP Check registers and or Check summary reports will do.
