Dear RTK Officer:

1. On June 20, 2013, Lee Mangan received a letter from Stefani Yosmanovich of the Pennsylvania DEP demanding to know why, 17 years after Worcester Township's adoption of its Act 537 plan, the area in the vicinity of Landis Road and Hickory Hill Road had not been sewerred. In her letter demanding a report of why this area had not been sewerred, Ms. Yosmanovich stated "In your report, please provide an explanation why this area has not been sewerred...."

Please provide to me, in electronic form and via email, the Township's report, prepared in response to Ms. Yosmanovich's inquiry.

2. On June 12, 2014, Lee Mangan received a letter from Jenifer Fields of the Pennsylvania DEP, which approved the Act 537 plan. In this approval letter, Ms. Fields states the following:

"Worcester Township will adopt a connection ordinance within 3 months from the date of this letter...a copy of the adopted ordinance should be sent to DEP within 30 days of adoption"

"DEP recommends that Worcester Township adopt a grinder pump ordinance..."
