

Right to Know Officer,

The following is a request for records made pursuant to the Right to Know Law ("RTKL"). Please be advised, the term "record" and "records" as used is defined under the Right to Know Law ("RTKL") as "Information, regardless of physical form or characteristics, that documents a transaction or activity of an agency and that is created, received or retained pursuant to law or in connection with a transaction, business or activity of the agency. The term includes a document, paper, letter, map, book, tape, photograph, film or sound recording, information stored or maintained electronically and a data-processed or image-processed document."

In his most recent LOSS in Appeal 2015-1807, M. Joseph Clement made an allegation that I have cost the taxpayers of Worcester Township an unverified sum of money. In the Appeal 2015-1807 it was discovered that Mr. Clement's firm billed Worcester Township for work they had done in Lower Gwynedd Township. Since I am not in control of the treasury of the Township and have absolutely no power over authorizing payment of the bills and making monetary



decisions, it seems strange that someone who's firm is BILLING US for work they do in another Township is pointing the finger at a taxpayer for the lack of fiduciary responsibility, discipline, and oversight by the Board.

In light of the foregoing, the following records are requested,

1. I would like copies of any and/or documents used by M. Joseph Clement to calculate, verify and/or justify his allegation in his unverified memorandum (per the OOR), in his most recent loss in AP 2015-1807, that I have cost the taxpayers of Worcester Township an unverified sum of money.
2. Any and/or all records of communication including but not limited to Emails, note, memos and faxes to and/or from the Worcester Board of Supervisors collectively and/or individually regarding the Methacton Conditional Use Application and/or field project and/or land development monthly from January 1, 2015 to present regardless as to whether they are on their personal computers and/or email accounts.
3. Any and/or all records of communication including but not limited to Emails, note, memos and faxes to and/or from the Worcester Board of Supervisors collectively and/or individually regarding the Methacton Conditional Use Application and/or field project and/or land development monthly from January 1, 2014 to January 1, 2015 regardless as to whether they are on their personal computers and/or email accounts.
4. I would like copies of any and/or all detailed billing invoices for legal services submitted by the Township Solicitor and/or his law firm Wisler, Pearlstine (the Township Solicitor's Firm) to Worcester Township monthly beginning January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2013. These would also correlate with the monthly payment of the bills check registers as a result of the timing of their submission.
5. Any and/or all monthly Client billing summaries from the law firm of Wisler Pearlstine showing expenditures for the Methacton Conditional Use Application and/or field project and/or land development from January 2012 to present.
6. A copy of the response to David Brooks August 18, 2010 RTK request and any and/or all documents produced in that response.
7. A copy of the response to Winnie Hays April 10, 2015 RTK request and any and/or all documents produced in that response.

I would like these in electronic medium as I assume that the Township Solicitor and his firm maintain these records in PDF format.
