You see, they're meant to carry rain water away and to help water flow easily from your home during a heavy rainfall. The water that runs into and through the storm drain system is not treated. It goes straight to our waterways, and ultimately to the lakes, rivers, streams and creeks.

Don't blow it - bag or compost your leaves or grass clippings. And please don't put anything - garbage, motor oil, paint, doggie doo or what-have-you - down the storm drain. Because it could wind up as 'ewww' on you.
