During an inspection of several bridges and culverts throughout the Township, the Township Engineer discovered a structural problem with the culvert located near 1790 Green Hill Road. As a precautionary measure this crossing will be closed to all traffic beginning tomorrow, Friday.

The Township Engineer is now working to prepare the needed fix, which may require that the culvert be replaced. Until this time the crossing will remain closed, and updates will be posted at the Township website, worcestertwp.com, at the "Top Topics" page, as soon as information becomes available.

Local fire and ambulance personnel, the Pennsylvania State Police, and the 911 dispatch center have been alerted to the closure. The Township has also notified the Methacton School District and the United States Post Office.

I apologize for the late notice. The Township Engineer's review was completed just last evening, and the Township wanted to address this matter immediately.
