

WORCESTER TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE No. 29

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF ALL DOGS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP LIMITS OF WORCESTER, PROVIDING PENALTIES, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

WHEREAS, it seems necessary to take further means to help secure the safety of persons and property within the township from dogs running at large, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Worcester, County of Montgomery and State of Pennsylvania, in stated meeting assembled, do hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS

The following words, when used in this ordinance, shall have the meaning ascribed to them in this section:

- a. "Owner" when applied to the proprietorship of a dog, shall include every person having a right of property in such dog, and every person who keeps or harbors such dog or has it in his care, and every person who permits such dog to remain on or about any premises occupied by him.
- b. "Person" shall include individuals, corporations, co-partnerships, and associations. Singular words shall include the plural. Masculine words shall include the feminine and neuter.
- c. "At Large" when used in reference to dogs shall mean off the premises of the owner unaccompanied by the owner, and not under the control of the owner.
- d. "Dog" shall mean both male and female.

SECTION 2. RUNNING AT LARGE PROHIBITED

On and after the effective date of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog or dogs, whether licensed or unlicensed, to permit such dog or dogs to run at large.

SECTION 3. PENALTIES

Any owner who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace of the Township of Worcester be sentenced to pay a fine to the Township of Worcester not exceeding \$25.00, and costs of prosecution, and in default of the payment thereof, the Justice of the Peace may commit the offender to imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed five (5) days.

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All existing Ordinances of the Township of Worcester are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after adoption thereof.

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, BY RECLASSIFYING AN AREA LOCATED AT AND NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF TOWNSHIP LINE ROAD AND WHITEHALL ROAD INTO A LIMITED INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT, AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP ACCORDINGLY.

WHEREAS, after due public notice and public hearing on said Zoning Ordinance and Map change, as provided by the Zoning Ordinance and the Township code, the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, do hereby enact and ordain:

SECTION 1. That area in Worcester Township, at Norritonville, and fronting on the Township Line Road and Whitehall Road and bounded as follows shall hereafter be LI-Limited Industrial District and zoning purposes:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of the center line of Whitehall Road with the center line of Township Line Road, thence along the said center line of Township Line Road in northwesterly direction for a distance of 905' to a point, thence in a north-easterly direction following the line dividing the property of Louise Hugel from the Posen & Kline property for a distance of 300' to a point, thence in a south-easterly direction following a line parallel to the center-line of Township Line Road to a point in the center line of Whitehall Road, thence in a south-westerly direction along the centerline of Whitehall Road to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. The proper officers are authorized to amend the Zoning Map to the change herein ordained.

Approved by the Supervisors of Worcester Township and enacted into an Ordinance the sixth day of July, 1959 A.D.
