

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, ROBERT M. KRAUSS, Executor of last Will and Testament of SOPHIA K. KRAUSS, deceased, by deed of dedication dated December 6, 1967 to the Township of Worcester, have conveyed all that certain irregular tract or piece of ground, situate in Worcester Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described and known as part of Morris Road and part of Valley Forge Road, to be used by the Township as a part of the two public roads;

AND WHEREAS, the said deed of dedication has been accepted and is recorded in the Recorder of Deeds' Office of Montgomery County in Deed Book *3519* page *150*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said part of the roads known as Morris Road and Valley Forge Road, bounded and described as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN irregular tract or piece of ground situate at the corner of Morris Road and Valley Forge Road, in the Township of Worcester, in the County of Montgomery, and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, more particularly bounded and described according to a survey made thereof by Henry S. Conrey, Inc., Registered Engineers, of Paoli, Pennsylvania, dated February of 1967, as follows, to wit:-

BEGINNING at a point marking the intersection of the southwest line of Morris Road (thirty-three feet wide) with the northwest line of Valley Forge Road (thirty-three feet wide) thence from said point of beginning and along the northwest line of Valley Forge Road south thirty-six degrees thirty-one minutes thirty seconds west forty feet and eighteen one-hundredths of a foot, thence along and through land of Sophia K. Krauss the following three courses: (1) north twenty-eight degrees fifty-five minutes forty-three seconds east thirteen feet and forty-one one-hundredths of a foot (2) on a line curving to the left having a radius of twenty-nine feet an arc distance of thirty-nine feet and ninety-seven one-hundredths of a foot and a chord bearing northwestwardly (3) north fifty degrees two minutes eleven seconds west seventy-three feet and fourteen one-hundredths of a foot to a point in the southwest line of Morris Road, thence along said line south fifty-two degrees east one hundred one feet and eighty-two one-hundredths of a foot to a point of beginning.

CONTAINING 381 square feet,

be and is hereby accepted as part of two public roads, to be and become a part of the public road system of the Township of Worcester, and that this resolution be recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for the County of

Montgomery, Pennsylvania.
