WORCESTER TOWNSHIP

MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE VACATING SLOUGH ROAD

An ordinance of the Township of Worcester, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, vacating Slough Road located on real property owned by William E. Sherry and Betty T. Sherry, h/w, situate on Quarry Hall Road, Worcester Township, Montgomery County, the said real property being Parcel 67-00-02914-00-7 and repealing any and all ordinances inconsistent therewith.

WHEREAS, William E. Sherry and Betty T. Sherry, h/w are owners of real property situate on Quarry Hall Road, Worcester Township, which real property is more fully described in Exhibit "A", which is attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the said real property is encumbered by a Right of Way known as Slough Road which Right of Way is more fully described in the subdivision plan prepared by David Meixner which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, Slough Road was intended to provide access to the said real property from Quarry Hall Road; and

WHEREAS, Slough Road was never dedicated to Worcester Township; and

WHEREAS, Slough Road is presently unopened, undeveloped, ungraded and otherwise unimproved; and

WHEREAS, Slough Road does not exist in fact but, rather, is only named as a Right of Way in the records of Worcester Township in the Board of Assessment of Montgomery County; and

WHEREAS, all property owners of land abutting or in any way affected by vacation have received the requisite written Notice of Action by the Board;

WHEREAS, The Board finds no property owner will suffer depreciation in property value by this vacation;

WHEREAS, Petitioners have agreed to release, indemnify and save harmless the Township of Worcester from any liability, direct or indirect, of any nature or kind whatsoever or wheresoever, and from any damage of any kind or nature arising out of, through, from or because of any of the actions of Worcester Township, direct or indirect, in relation to the vacation of Slough Road.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township finds that it is in the best interests of Worcester Township and all its citizens and tax payers to vacate Slough Road.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township finds that Slough Road is not necessary for public conveniences.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township finds that it is necessary for the public convenience to vacate Slough Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township, pursuant to Authority Granted by the Act of June 1, 1955, Public Law 2021, do hereby enact and ordain:

That Slough Road described herein, Worcester Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, is hereby vacated.

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND situate in the Township of Worcester, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit;

ALL THAT CERTAIN 50 foot wide right-of-way (known as Slough Road) as shown on subdivision Plan made for William E. Sherry made by Meixner, Civil Engineers and Surveyors dated 5/8/67 revision Number One dated 9/8/1967 as follows to wit:


BEGINNING at a point on the Northwest side of Quarry Hall Road (33 feet wide) (ultimate width 60 feet wide) (a/k/a/ School Lane); thence extending from said point of beginning and extending along Lot No. 3 as shown on the aforementioned survey North 45 degrees 51 minutes West 229.00 feet more or less to a point; thence extending along Lot No. 3 North 44 degrees 00 minutes East 50 feet to a point in line of lands of now or late of W.L. Crist as shown on the aforementioned Survey; thence extending along lands now or late of W.L. Crist and lands now or late of R.E. Crist the two following courses and distances; (1) South 45 degrees 51 minutes East 145.20 feet more or less to a point, an angle; and (2) South 41 degrees 52 minutes 30 seconds East 83.80 feet to a point on the Northwest side of Quarry Hall Road aforesaid; thence extending along the Northwest side of Quarry Hall Road South 44 degrees 00 minutes West 50 feet to the first mentioned point and place of beginning.

ORDINANCE NO. 93

WORCESTER TOWNSHIP
MONTGOMERY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING ACT 68 OF 1985 ENACTED
BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING GUIDELINES AND LIMITATIONS
FOR THE COMPENSATION OF SUPERVISORS OF TOWNSHIPS
OF THE SECOND CLASS

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the Second Class; and

WHEREAS, said Act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of not more than 4,999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00); and

WHEREAS, the population of Worcester Township is less than 4,999; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes Boards of Supervisors of the various townships of the Second Class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors

of Worcester Township to set compensation for Supervisors on a per meeting basis and within the limitations of Act 68;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township as follows:

1. Each Supervisor of Worcester Township elected or appointed to office on or after November 5, 1985, shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the Board of Supervisors at the rate of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each meeting attended by such Supervisor.

2. No Supervisor shall receive annual compensation under this Ordinance in excess of the annual statutory limit set by the General Assembly in Act 68 for supervisors of townships within the appropriate population category.

3. No Supervisor shall be compensated for attending any meetings of the Board of Supervisors in excess of fifteen (15) meetings per year; such absence of compensation shall not negate nor in any way effect such Supervisor's duty or obligation to attend such uncompensated meetings.


4. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly installments.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1986.
