The Worcester Township Board of Supervisors, during its scheduled meeting on May 19, 2021, will conduct a Public Hearing commencing after 7:30PM at Community Hall, 1031 Valley Forge Rd, Fairview Village, to consider enactment of the following Ordinance:

Ordinance 2021-284. An Ordinance to amend the Code of Worcester Township as to: (1) accessory use structure regulations for Conservation Subdivisions; (2) accessory use swimming pool setback regulations; (3) fence height and setback regulations; (4) impervious coverage regulations for non-residential uses in the AGR Agricultural District; (5) review and approvals regarding proposed location of certain on-lot septic systems; (6) deletion of yard sale permit requirements; (7) requirements for installation of emergency entry boxes, truss identification signage, and address signage at structures and properties; and, (8) requirements for discharges to the Township sanitary sewer system, additional fees required to be paid for certain discharges, prohibited discharges, and the setting of violations for penalties for violations thereof.
