Community Hall & Heyser Field **1031 Valley Forge Road, Worcester Township**

Located in the heart of Fairview Village, Worcester Township's Community Hall and Heyser Field together comprise an 8.89-acre public property that serves as a central space for community meetings, recreational use, and local events.

Community Hall

The Community Hall serves as a key indoor venue for Township meetings, educational programs, and small group gatherings. It is a simple, functional space equipped for public use. Please note that food and beverages are not permitted inside the hall.

Heyser Field

Heyser Field is an open space adjacent to the hall, offering several outdoor amenities:

- A maintained horse ring suitable for equestrian activities and local events
- A children's playground area with swings and room for free play

Parking for Heyser Field is available in the Community Hall lot.

Community Use and Events

The property regularly hosts public events, such as community markets and seasonal activities, and serves as a popular gathering place for residents.

Rental Information

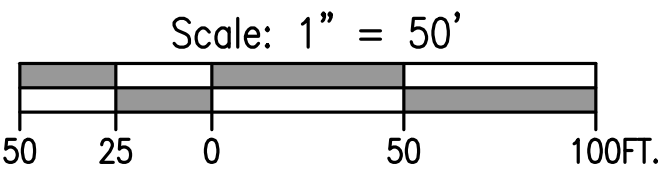
